



Guided Tour: Sweet and Savoury Leuven Ladeuzeneuzen

For those who want to (re)discover Leuven or want to get more acquainted with this medieval city through her sweet and salty tastes. During this peculiar walk you hear juicy stories and interesting facts about this University City with its city slogan 'alive and kicking', while your Burgundian soul will be spoilt with tastings in outstanding shops within the inner city wall.

This tour can be organised in the morning or in the afternoon, on Saturdays and during weekdays. It can be organised as a separate tour or in combination with other activities. We will be glad to make you a tailored program.

Starting point: Square Ladeuze (at the artwork 'Totem' of Jan Fabre). A different starting point can be considered. The square Ladeuze is a 10 minutes walk away from the train station of Leuven. There is a car park underneath the Square Ladeuze (www.mappy.be).

Duration: 2 or 3 hours. We request customers to be present at the starting point 10 minutes before departure. If we start later, we might be forced to adjust the planned program.

Price: € 12 or € 18 per person

Included: 2 hours: guide, 3 tastings & 21% VAT

3 hours: guide, 2 tastings & 1 drink in a Leuven café & 21 % VAT

When the group exceeds 25 participants, it can be divided in subsets. Each subset will walk with its own guide. The different groups can meet at the last tasting. When the group is less than 12 persons, we ask a compensation of 8 euro per person less than 12.

The walk can be guided in Dutch, French and English.
